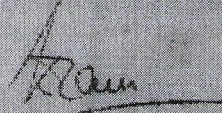

New Delhi, the 21st August, 1952.

The undersigned is directed to state that the Cabinet at its meeting held on August 11, 1952, decided that, in future, there should be only three classes of Ministers, namely, Cabinet Ministers, Ministers and Deputy Ministers. The practice so far followed of describing a Minister as Minister of State, when assisting a Cabinet Minister in charge of the same Ministry, will accordingly be discontinued and the following designations approved by the Prime Minister, will be adopted for the Ministers concerned:-

Shri C.D. Deshmukh.	- Minister of Finance.
Shri Mahavir Tyagi.	- Minister of Revenue & Expenditure
Shri Rafi Ahmed Kidwai.	- Minister of Food & Agriculture.
Shri Panjabrao S. Deshmukh.	- Minister of Agriculture.
Shri T.T. Krishnamachari.	- Minister of Commerce & Industry.
Shri D.P. Karmarkar.	- Minister of Commerce.

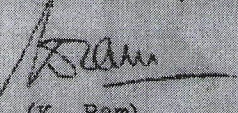

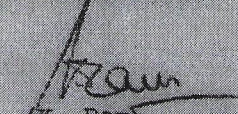
